Group forms intends to accelerate mobile WiMAX in UK

BARCELONA (WiMAX Day). The Mobile WiMAX Acceleration Group (M-WAG), a collaboration of companies demonstrating the business case for the use of mobile WiMAX, has unveiled plans for a mobile WiMAX pilot network (over 2.5GHz) in Maidstone, Kent. M-WAG will conduct multi-application user trials using mobile WiMAX over 7.5 square kilometers from the centre of Maidstone; home to over 75,000 people and 4,500 businesses. M-WAG member companies will provide all network equipment (conforming to [IEEE](#) Standard 802.16e where relevant) and service integration. The pilot is scheduled to go live in April, but specifics on it have not yet been released.
